<p><u>A</u>ssessment (Data Collection-Cues)</p> <p><u>Subjective data:</u></p> <p><u>Why did the patient seek healthcare?</u></p> <p><u>Is this still an ongoing problem?</u></p> <p><u>Objective data:</u> Abnormal assessment findings,Vital signs,lab results,Dx test results, Significant PMH</p> <p>Braden score ____Fall risk ____</p> <p>What assessment information is most important?</p> <p>What is of immediate concern?</p>	<p><u>Problem Identification List</u></p> <p>recognizing and analyzing cues</p> <p>Actual Problems /Potential Problems</p> <p>What client conditions are consistent with the cues?</p> <p>Are there cues that support or contraindicate a particular condition?</p>	<p><u>D</u>iagnosis (Nursing Diagnosis)</p> <p><u>Does not need to be NANDA</u></p> <p>List top 3 priority problems in order of priority using Maslow's Hierarchy, ABC's, acute before chronic, acute before chronic, stable before unstable and explain.</p> <p>Problem #1</p> <p>Problem #2</p> <p>Problem #3</p>
