## **Volunteer in our Crisis and Development Center:**

North Raleigh Ministries Crisis and Development Center is a fast-paced and vibrant environment, where you can see the direct impact of our mission. Group sessions include a brief overview of our programs and mission, a full tour of the food pantry operations, and hands-on experience processing and packing groceries.

- Group Availability: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday between 10:30 am-2 pm, and Wednesday between 3:30 pm -7 pm
- Time Commitment: Minimum of 2 hours
- Minimum Age to Volunteer: 11 years old, and minors ages 11-15 must be accompanied by an adult
- Group Size: 5-15 people
- Requirements: Please wear close-toed shoes and have hair tied back. Volunteering in the food pantry requires standing, lifting, and pushing carts.

## Support our ministry by volunteering in one of our Thrift Shoppes:

Volunteer in our collaborative and fast-paced Thrift Stores where you never know what kind of treasure you will find! Sessions include sorting through donated goods, and stocking and organizing the sales floor.

- Group Availability: Tuesday-Saturday between 9 am-2 pm
- Time Commitment: Minimum of 2 hours
- Minimum Age to Volunteer: 11 years old, and minors ages 11-15 must be accompanied by an adult
- Group Size: 3-20 people
- Requirements: Please wear close-toed shoes. Volunteering in the thrift stores include standing and lifting up to 20lbs.
