**1 John 2** <sup>20</sup> But the Holy One has anointed you and you all know *the truth*. <sup>27</sup> But the wonderful anointing you have received from God is so much greater than their deception and now lives in you. There's no need for anyone to keep teaching you. His anointing teaches you all that you need to know, for it will lead you into truth, not a counterfeit. So just as the anointing has taught you, remain in him. TPT

### Seven Anointings: Cyrus, Zerubbabel, Gideon, Daniel, Mordecai, Joseph, David

Chuck Pierce – July 13, 1997 - ...we will have a Gideon Anointing upon us. ...I will deliver the enemy camp fully into your hands. Everything that has been broken there will start a reversal and I say My people will arise, I will shine on this state. I will begin to awaken it and you will be used to touch this nation in days ahead.

**Judges 6** <sup>1</sup> The Israelites did evil in the LORD's sight. So the LORD handed them over to the Midianites for seven years. <sup>6</sup> So Israel was reduced to starvation by the Midianites. Then the Israelites cried out to the LORD for help. <sup>7</sup> When they cried out to the LORD because of Midian, <sup>8</sup> the LORD sent a prophet to the Israelites. He said, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I brought you up out of slavery in Egypt. <sup>9</sup> I rescued you from the Egyptians and from all who oppressed you. I drove out your enemies and gave you their land. <sup>10</sup> I told you, 'I am the LORD your God. You must not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you now live.' But you have not listened to me." <sup>11</sup> Then the angel of the LORD came and sat beneath the great tree at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash of the clan of Abiezer. Gideon son of Joash was threshing wheat at the bottom of a winepress to hide the grain from the Midianites. <sup>12</sup> The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said, "Mighty hero, the LORD is with you!" <sup>13</sup> "Sir," Gideon replied, "if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? And where are all the miracles our ancestors told us about? Didn't they say,

‘The LORD brought us up out of Egypt’? But now the LORD has abandoned us and handed us over to the Midianites.”<sup>14</sup> Then the LORD turned to him and said, **“Go with the strength you have, and rescue Israel from the Midianites. I am sending you!”**<sup>15</sup> “But Lord,” Gideon replied, “how can I rescue Israel? My clan is the weakest in the whole tribe of Manasseh, and I am the least in my entire family!”<sup>16</sup> **The LORD said to him, “I will be with you. And you will destroy the Midianites as if you were fighting against one man.”**<sup>24</sup> And **Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and named it Yahweh-Shalom (which means “the LORD is peace”).** The altar remains in Ophrah in the land of the clan of Abiezer to this day.<sup>25</sup> **That night the LORD said to Gideon, “Take the second bull from your father’s herd, the one that is seven years old. Pull down your father’s altar to Baal, and cut down the Asherah pole standing beside it.**<sup>26</sup> Then **build an altar to the LORD your God** here on this hilltop sanctuary, laying the stones carefully. Sacrifice the bull as a burnt offering on the altar, using as fuel the wood of the Asherah pole you cut down.”<sup>32</sup> **From then on Gideon was called Jerub-baal, which means “Let Baal defend himself,” because he broke down Baal’s altar.**<sup>34</sup> **Then the Spirit of the LORD clothed Gideon with power.** He blew a ram’s horn as a call to arms...

**Judges 7**<sup>1</sup> **So Jerub-baal (that is, Gideon) and his army got up early...**<sup>2</sup> **The LORD said to Gideon, “You have too many warriors with you. If I let all of you fight the Midianites, the Israelites will boast to me that they saved themselves by their own strength.**<sup>3</sup> Therefore, tell the people, ‘Whoever is timid or afraid may leave this mountain and go home.’” So 22,000 of them went home, leaving only 10,000 who were willing to fight.<sup>4</sup> But the LORD told Gideon, “There are still too many! Bring them down to the spring, and **I will test them to determine who will go with you and who will not.**<sup>7</sup> **The LORD told Gideon, “With these 300 men I will rescue you and give you victory over the Midianites. Send all the others home.”**<sup>9</sup> **That night the LORD said, “Get up! Go down into the Midianite camp, for I have given you victory over them!”**<sup>14</sup> His companion answered, **“Your dream can mean only one thing—God has given Gideon son of Joash, the Israelite, victory over Midian and all its allies!”**<sup>15</sup> When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed in worship before the LORD. Then he returned to the Israelite camp and shouted, **“Get up! For the LORD has given you victory over the Midianite hordes!”**<sup>21</sup> **Each man stood at his position around the camp and watched as all the Midianites rushed around in a panic, shouting as they ran to escape.**<sup>22</sup> **When the 300 Israelites blew their rams’ horns, the LORD caused the warriors in the camp to fight against each other with their swords.**

**Isaiah 10**<sup>27</sup> It shall come to pass in that day *That* his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And **the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing** oil. NKJV
