A Gideon Anointing

Chuck Pierce – July 13, 1997 - Because we have gathered together God has started the process for us to double. When the Board of Reference reaches 300 churches we will have a **Gideon Anointing** upon us. (**Judges 7:15** ¹⁵ **When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed in worship before the LORD. Then he returned to the Israelite camp and shouted, "Get up! For the LORD has given you victory over the Midianite hordes!"**.) Chuck declared that when 300 churches network together across the state, **I will deliver the enemy camp fully into your hands.** Everything that has been broken there will start a reversal and I say My people will arise, **I will shine on this state.** I will begin to awaken it and **you will be used to touch this nation in days ahead.**

Judges 6 ¹ **The Israelites did evil in the LORD's sight. So the LORD handed them over to the Midianites for seven years.** ⁶ **So Israel was reduced to starvation by the Midianites. Then the Israelites cried out to the LORD for help.** ⁷ When they cried out to the LORD because of Midian, ⁸ **the LORD sent a prophet to the Israelites.** He said, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I brought you up out of slavery in Egypt. ⁹ I rescued you from the Egyptians and from all who oppressed you. I drove out your enemies and gave you their land. ¹⁰ I told you, 'I am the LORD your God. **You must not worship the gods of the Amorites,** in whose land you now live.' **But you have not listened to me.**" ¹¹ **Then the angel of the LORD came** and sat beneath the great tree at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash of the clan of Abiezer. Gideon son of Joash was threshing wheat at the bottom of a winepress to hide the grain from the Midianites. ¹² **The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said, "Mighty hero, the LORD is with you!"** ¹³ "Sir," Gideon replied, "if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? And where are all the miracles our ancestors told us about? Didn't they say, 'The LORD brought us up out of Egypt'? But now the LORD has abandoned us and handed us over to the Midianites." ¹⁴ Then the LORD turned to him and said, "**Go with the strength you have, and rescue Israel from the Midianites. I am sending you!**" ¹⁵ "But Lord," Gideon replied, "how can I rescue Israel? My clan is the weakest in the whole tribe of Manasseh, and I am the least in my entire family!" ¹⁶ **The LORD said to him, "I will be with you. And you will destroy the Midianites as if you were fighting against one man."** ¹⁷ Gideon replied, "If you are truly going to help me, show me a sign to prove that it is really the LORD speaking to me. ¹⁸ Don't go away until I come back and bring my offering to you." He answered, "I will stay here until you return." ²¹ Then the angel of the LORD touched the meat and bread with the tip of the staff in his hand, and fire flamed up from the rock and consumed all he had brought. And the angel of the LORD disappeared. ²² When Gideon realized that it was the angel of the LORD, he cried out, "Oh, Sovereign LORD, I'm doomed! I have seen the angel of the LORD face to face!" ²³ "It is all right," the LORD replied. "Do not be afraid. You will not die." ²⁴ And **Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and named it Yahweh-Shalom (which means "the LORD is**

peace”). The altar remains in Ophrah in the land of the clan of Abiezer to this day. ²⁵ **That night the LORD said to Gideon**, “Take the second bull from your father’s herd, the one that is seven years old. **Pull down your father’s altar to Baal, and cut down the Asherah pole** standing beside it. ²⁶ Then **build an altar to the LORD your God** here on this hilltop sanctuary, laying the stones carefully. Sacrifice the bull as a burnt offering on the altar, using as fuel the wood of the Asherah pole you cut down.” ²⁷ So Gideon took ten of his servants and did as the LORD had commanded. But he did it at night because he was afraid of the other members of his father’s household and the people of the town. ³² **From then on Gideon was called Jerub-baal, which means “Let Baal defend himself,” because he broke down Baal’s altar.** ³³ Soon afterward the armies of Midian, Amalek, and the people of the east formed an alliance against Israel and crossed the Jordan, camping in the valley of Jezreel. ³⁴ **Then the Spirit of the LORD clothed Gideon with power.** He blew a ram’s horn as a call to arms... ³⁶ Then Gideon said to God, “If you are truly going to use me to rescue Israel as you promised, ³⁷ prove it to me in this way.

Judges 7 ¹ **So Jerub-baal (that is, Gideon) and his army got up early...² The LORD said to Gideon, “You have too many warriors with you. If I let all of you fight the Midianites, the Israelites will boast to me that they saved themselves by their own strength.** ³ Therefore, tell the people, ‘Whoever is timid or afraid may leave this mountain and go home.’” So 22,000 of them went home, leaving only 10,000 who were willing to fight. ⁴ But the LORD told Gideon, “There are still too many! Bring them down to the spring, and **I will test them to determine who will go with you and who will not.**” ⁶ Only 300 of the men drank from their hands. All the others got down on their knees and drank with their mouths in the stream.

⁷ **The LORD told Gideon, “With these 300 men I will rescue you and give you victory over the Midianites. Send all the others home.”** ⁸ So Gideon collected the provisions and rams’ horns of the other warriors and sent them home. But he kept the 300 men with him. The Midianite camp was in the valley just below Gideon. ⁹ **That night the LORD said, “Get up! Go down into the Midianite camp, for I have given you victory over them!** ¹⁰ But if you are afraid to attack, go down to the camp with your servant Purah. ¹¹ Listen to what the Midianites are saying, and you will be greatly encouraged. Then you will be eager to attack.” ¹⁴ His companion answered, **“Your dream can mean only one thing—God has given Gideon son of Joash, the Israelite, victory over Midian and all its allies!”** ¹⁵ When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed in worship before the LORD. Then he returned to the Israelite camp and shouted, **“Get up! For the LORD has given you victory over the Midianite hordes!”** ¹⁶ He divided the 300 men into three groups and gave each man a ram’s horn and a clay jar with a torch in it. ¹⁷ Then he said to them, “Keep your eyes on me. When I come to the edge of the camp, do just as I do. ¹⁸ As soon as I and those with me blow the rams’ horns, blow your horns, too, all around the entire camp, and shout, ‘For the LORD and for Gideon!’” ²¹ **Each man stood at his position around the camp and watched as all the Midianites rushed around in a panic, shouting as they ran to escape.** ²² **When the 300 Israelites blew their rams’ horns, the LORD caused the warriors in the camp to fight against each other with their swords.**

Isaiah 10 ²⁷ It shall come to pass in that day *That* his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And **the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing** oil. NKJV
