God Loves You

1 John 4 ⁷ Those who are loved by God, let his love continually pour from you to one another, because **God is love**. Everyone who loves is fathered by God and experiences an intimate knowledge of him. ⁸ The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for **God is love**. ⁹ The light of God's love shined within us when he sent his matchless Son into the world so that we might live through him. ¹⁰ **This is love: He loved us long before we loved him. It was his love, not ours. He proved it by sending his Son to be the pleasing sacrificial offering to take away our sins.** ¹¹ **Delightfully loved ones**, if he loved us with such tremendous love, then "loving one another" should be our way of life! TPT

John 3 ¹⁵ so that those who truly believe in him will not perish but be given eternal life. ¹⁶ **For here is the way God loved the world—he gave his only, unique Son as a gift. So now everyone who believes in him will never perish but experience everlasting life.** ¹⁷ "God did not send his Son into the world to judge and condemn the world, but to be its Savior and

rescue it! ¹⁸ So now there is no longer any condemnation for those who believe in him... TPT

John 15 ⁹ **"I love each of you with the same love that the Father loves me. You must continually let my love nourish your hearts."** ¹⁰ If you keep my commands, you will live in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands, for I continually live nourished and empowered by his love. ¹¹ My purpose for telling you these things is so that the joy that I experience will fill your hearts with overflowing gladness! ¹² "So this is my command: Love each other deeply, as much as I have loved you. ¹³ For the greatest love of all is a love that sacrifices all. And this great love is demonstrated when a person sacrifices his life for his friends. TPT

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ **'For I know the plans that I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope.'** ¹² Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. ¹³ You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart. ¹⁴ I will be found by you,' declares the LORD...NASB

¹¹ For I know the plans *and* thoughts that I have for you,' says the LORD, **'plans for peace (shalom, wealth, salvation, prosperity) and well-being** and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. AMP

Psalm 139 ¹ **Lord, you know everything there is to know about me.** ² You perceive every movement of my heart and soul, and you understand my every thought before it even enters my mind. ³⁻⁴ You are so intimately aware of me, Lord. You read my heart like an open book and you know all the words I'm about to speak before I even start a sentence! You know every step I will take before my journey even begins. ⁵ You've gone into my future to prepare the way, and in kindness you follow behind me to spare me from the harm of my past. **You have laid your hand on me!** ⁶ This is just too wonderful, deep, and incomprehensible! Your understanding of me brings me wonder and strength. ¹³ You formed my innermost being, shaping my delicate inside and my intricate outside, and wove them all together in my mother's womb. ¹⁴ I thank you, God, for making me so mysteriously complex! Everything you do is marvelously breathtaking. It simply amazes me to think about it! How thoroughly you know me, Lord! ¹⁵ You even formed every bone in my body when you created me in the secret place; carefully, skillfully you shaped me from nothing to something. ¹⁶ **You saw who you created me to be before I became me!** *Before I'd ever seen the light of day,* the number of days you planned for me were already recorded in your book. ¹⁷⁻¹⁸ **Every single moment you are thinking of me!** How precious and wonderful to consider that you cherish me constantly in

your every thought! O God, your desires toward me are more than the grains of sand on every shore! TPT

Proverbs 4 ¹⁸ But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, That shines brighter and brighter until the full day. NASB

Nothing Too Hard

Genesis 18 ¹³ Then the LORD said to Abraham, “Why did Sarah laugh? Why did she say, ‘Can an old woman like me have a baby?’ ¹⁴ **Is anything too hard for the LORD?** I will return about this time next year, and Sarah will have a son.” NLT

¹³ Yahweh *knew her thoughts* and asked Abraham, “Why is Sarah laughing, saying, ‘How can a woman my age have a baby?’ ¹⁴ **Do you think there is anything too marvelous for Yahweh?** I will appear to you at the appointed time next year and Sarah will have a son!” TPT

Jeremiah 32 ¹⁷ **“O Sovereign LORD! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you!”** ²⁷ “I am the LORD, the God of all the peoples of the world. **Is anything too hard for me?** NLT

Mark 10 ²⁷ Jesus looked at them intently and said, “Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But not with God. Everything is possible with God.” TPT

Luke 1 ³⁷ Not one promise from God is empty of power. Nothing is impossible with God!” TPT

Mark 9 ²³ Jesus said to him, “What do you mean ‘if’? If you are able to believe, all things are possible to the believer.” TPT

He Hears You

James 4 ² ...And all the time you don’t obtain what you want because you won’t ask God for it! TPT

1 John 5 ¹³ I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life. ¹⁴ And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. ¹⁵ And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for. TPT

John 15 ⁷ But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! TPT

Matthew 6 ⁹ Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. ¹⁰ May your Kingdom come

soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. TPT

Matthew 6 ²⁵ “That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn’t life more than food, and your body more than clothing? ²⁶ Look at the birds. They don’t plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren’t you far more valuable to him than they are? ²⁷ Can all your worries add a single moment to your life? ²⁸ “And why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don’t work or make their clothing, ²⁹ yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. ³⁰ And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith? ³¹ “So don’t worry about these things, saying, ‘What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?’ ³² These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. ³³ Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. ³⁴ “So don’t worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today’s trouble is enough for today. TPT

Why Worry?

Psalm 55 ²² Give your burdens to the LORD, and he will take care of you. He will not permit the godly to slip and fall. ²³ But you, O God, will send the wicked down to the pit of destruction... TPT

1 Peter 5 ⁷ Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you. TPT

NOTE: Or “Load upon him your every anxiety, for he is always watching over you with tender care.”

Philippians 4 ⁶ Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. TPT
