Spiritual Warfare is a Part of Revival April 2, 2023 – Part 3

Acts 3 ¹⁹ And now you must <u>repent</u> and <u>turn back to God</u> so that your <u>sins</u> will be <u>removed</u>, and so that <u>times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence</u>. ²⁰ And he will send you <u>Jesus</u>, <u>the Messiah</u>, <u>the appointed one</u>. ²¹ For he must remain in heaven <u>until the restoration</u> of all things has taken place, fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy prophets. TPT

Proverb 13 ²² The benevolent man leaves an inheritance that endures to his children's children, but the wealth of the wicked is treasured up for the righteous.

1 Samuel 30 1 Now it happened, when David and his men came to Ziklag, on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the South and Ziklag, attacked Ziklag and burned it with fire, ² and had taken captive the women and those who were there, from small to great; they did not kill anyone, but carried them away and went their way. 3 So David and his men came to the city, and there it was, burned with fire; and their wives, their sons, and their daughters had been taken captive. ⁴ Then David and the people who were with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep. 5 And David's two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the widow of Nabal the Carmelite, had been taken captive. ⁶ Now **David was greatly distressed**, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God. ⁷ Then David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, "Please bring the ephod here to me." And Abiathar brought the ephod to David. 8 So David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?" And He answered him, "Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all." 9 So David went, he and the six hundred men who were with him, and came to the Brook Besor, where those stayed who were left behind. 10 But David pursued, he and four hundred men; for two hundred stayed behind, who were so weary that they could not cross the Brook Besor. 11 Then they found an Egyptian in the field... 13 Then David said to him, "To whom do you belong, and where are you from?" And he said, "I am a young man from Egypt, servant of an Amalekite... 14 ... and we burned Ziklag with fire." ¹⁶ And when he had brought him down, there they were, spread out over all the land, eating and drinking and dancing, because of all the great spoil which they had taken from the land of the Philistines and from the land of Judah. 17 Then David attacked them from twilight until the evening of the next day. Not a man of them escaped, except four hundred young men who rode on camels and fled. 18 So David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away, and David rescued his two wives. 19 And nothing of theirs was lacking, either small or great, sons or

daughters, spoil or anything which they had taken from them; David recovered all. 20 Then David took all the flocks and herds they had driven before those other livestock, and said, "This is David's spoil." 21 Now David came to the two hundred men who had been so weary that they could not follow David, whom they also had made to stay at the Brook Besor. So they went out to meet David and to meet the people who were with him. And when David came near the people, he greeted them. 22 Then all the wicked and worthless men of those who went with David answered and said, "Because they did not go with us, we will not give them any of the spoil that we have recovered, except for every man's wife and children, that they may lead them away and depart." 23 But David said, "My brethren, you shall not do so with what the LORD has given us, who has preserved us and delivered into our hand the troop that came against us. 24 For who will heed you in this matter? But as his part is who goes down to the battle, so shall his part be who stays by the supplies; they shall share alike." NKJV

Ephesians 6 ¹² Your hand-to-hand combat is not with human beings, but with the highest principalities and authorities operating in rebellion under the heavenly realms. For they are a powerful class of demon-gods and evil spirits that hold this dark world in bondage. TPT

Luke 10 ¹⁹ Now you understand that <u>I have imparted to you my authority to trample over his kingdom</u>. You will trample upon every demon before you and <u>overcome every power Satan possesses</u>. <u>Absolutely nothing will harm you as you walk in this authority</u>. TPT

Mark 16 ¹⁵ And he said to them, "As you go into all the world, preach openly the wonderful news of the gospel to the entire human race! ¹⁶ Whoever believes the good news and is baptized will be saved, and whoever does not believe the good news will be condemned. ¹⁷ **And these miracle signs will accompany those who believe**: **They will drive out demons in the power of my name**. They will speak in tongues. TPT

Matthew 12 ²⁴ But when the *P'rushim* heard of it, they said, "It is only by <u>Ba'al-Zibbul</u>" — <u>the ruler of the demons</u> — "that this man drives out demons ²⁸ <u>But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God</u>, <u>then the Kingdom of God has come upon you!</u> ²⁹ "Or again, how can someone break into a strong man's house and make off with his possessions unless he <u>first ties up the strong man</u>? After that he can <u>ransack his house</u>. CJB
