**John 10** <sup>10</sup> A thief has only one thing in mind—he wants to steal, slaughter, and destroy. But **I have come to give you everything in abundance, more than you expect**—life in its fullness until you overflow! TPT

**Proverbs 10** <sup>22</sup> **The blessing of the LORD makes one rich**, and He adds no sorrow with it. NKJV

**Proverbs 13** <sup>22</sup> A good *man* leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the **wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous**. NKJV

**Psalms 105** <sup>37</sup> **At last, God freed all the Hebrews from their slavery and sent them away laden with the silver and gold of Egypt. And not even one was feeble on their way out!** TPT

**Psalms 112** <sup>1</sup> Shout in celebration of praise to the Lord! Everyone who loves the Lord and delights in him will cherish his words and **be blessed beyond expectation**. <sup>2</sup> **Their descendants will be prosperous and influential**. Every generation of the righteous will experience his favor. <sup>3</sup> **Great blessing and wealth fills the house of the wise**, for their integrity endures forever. <sup>7</sup> They will not live in fear or dread of what may come, for their hearts are firm, ever secure in their faith. <sup>8</sup> Steady and strong, they will not be afraid, but will calmly face their every foe until they all go down in defeat. <sup>9</sup> Never stingy and always generous to those in need, they lived lives of influence and honor that will never be forgotten, for they were full of good deeds. TPT

**Deuteronomy 28** <sup>2</sup> **You will experience all these blessings if you obey the LORD your God:**  
<sup>6</sup> Wherever you go and whatever you do, you will be blessed. <sup>11</sup> **"The LORD will give you prosperity in the land he swore to your ancestors to give you, blessing you with many children, numerous livestock, and abundant crops.** <sup>12</sup> The LORD will send rain at the proper time from his rich treasury in the heavens and will bless all the work you do. You will lend to many nations, but you will never need to borrow from them. <sup>13</sup> If you listen to these commands of the LORD your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the LORD will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom... <sup>47</sup> **If you do not** serve the LORD your God with joy and enthusiasm for the abundant benefits you have received, <sup>48</sup> you will serve your enemies whom the LORD will send against you. **You will be left hungry, thirsty, naked, and lacking in everything.** The LORD will put an iron yoke on your neck, oppressing you harshly until he has destroyed you. <sup>51b</sup> They will leave you no grain, new wine, olive oil, calves, or lambs, and **you will starve to death.** <sup>63</sup> **"Just as the LORD has found great pleasure in causing you to prosper and multiply,** the LORD will find pleasure in destroying you. You will be torn from the land you are about to enter and occupy. <sup>68</sup> Then the LORD will send you back to Egypt in ships, to a destination I promised you would never see again. **There you will offer to sell yourselves to your enemies as slaves, but no one will buy you.**" NLT

**Galatians 3** <sup>13</sup> **Yet, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law.** He absorbed the curse completely as **he became a curse in our place**. For it is written: "Everyone who is hung upon a tree is cursed." <sup>14</sup> Jesus Christ dissolved the curse from our lives, **so that in him all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon gentiles**. And now through faith we receive the promised Holy Spirit *who lives in us*. TPT

**Isaiah 53** <sup>4</sup> Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. NKJV

**2 Corinthians 5** <sup>21</sup> For God made the only one who did not know sin to become sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God through our union with him. TPT

**Romans 5** <sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. <sup>17</sup> For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. NKJV

**1 Corinthians 1** <sup>30</sup> But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, NASB

**2 Corinthians 8** <sup>9</sup> For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that although he was infinitely rich, he impoverished himself for our sake, so that by his poverty, we become rich beyond measure. TPT

**Malachi 3** <sup>8</sup> "Should people cheat God? Yet you have cheated me! "But you ask, 'What do you mean? When did we ever cheat you?' "You have cheated me of the tithes and offerings due to me. <sup>9</sup> You are under a curse, for your whole nation has been cheating me. <sup>10</sup> Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the LORD of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test! NLT

**David - 1 Samuel 30** <sup>1</sup> ...on the third day... <sup>2b</sup> ...carried *them* away and went their way. <sup>6b</sup> But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God. <sup>8</sup> So David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?" And He answered him, "Pursue, for you shall surely overtake *them* and without fail recover all." <sup>19</sup> And nothing of theirs was lacking, either small or great, sons or daughters, spoil or anything which they had taken from them; David recovered all. NKJV

**Jehoshaphat - 2 Chronicles 20** <sup>12</sup> O our God, will You not judge them? For we have no power against this great multitude that is coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are upon You. <sup>15</sup> ...'Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's. <sup>17</sup> You will not need to fight in this battle... Do not fear or be dismayed; <sup>20b</sup> Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper." <sup>21</sup> "Praise the LORD, For His mercy endures forever." <sup>22</sup> Now when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated. <sup>23b</sup> ...they helped to destroy one another. <sup>25</sup> When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away their spoil, they found among them an abundance of valuables on the dead bodies, and precious jewelry, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away; and they were three days gathering the spoil because there was so much. NKJV
