

That I May Know Him In Your Presence is Fullness of Joy The Spirit of Holiness

Philippians 3 ¹⁰ <u>that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection</u> and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; NASB

Psalms 16 ¹¹ You will make known to me the way of life; **In Your presence is fullness of joy**; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever. NASB

Hosea 4 ^{6a} My people are being destroyed because they don't know me. NLT

John 14 ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you <u>another Advocate</u>, who will never leave you.
¹⁷ <u>He is the Holy Spirit</u>, <u>who leads into all truth</u>. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because <u>he lives with you now and later will be in you</u>. NLT

Luke 1 ³⁵ Gabriel answered, "<u>The Spirit of Holiness</u> will fall upon you and almighty God will spread his shadow of power over you in a cloud of glory! This is why <u>the child born to you will be holy</u>, <u>and he will be called the Son of God</u>. TPT

1 Peter 1 ¹⁶ For the Scriptures say, "You must be holy because I am holy." NLT

Note: Everything about God is holy. True holiness includes justice, mercy, truth, and righteousness. To be holy is to be absolutely devoted to God in all that we do, demonstrating who he is to the world. Holiness surrounds God's throne and we are seated with him in heavenly places (Eph 2:6). The Hebraic concept of holiness is "set apart"; that is, we are a people set apart for God, even as god is "set apart" from all gods. Grace has imbedded holiness into our lives, yet we are to make right choices and to yield to Christ and God's Word as the Holy Spirit lives in us. Holiness is not merely actions we perform, but what we absorb and manifest as we live our lives in God's presence. Christ is our holiness (1 Cor 1:30).

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ For it is not from man that we draw our life but from God as we are being joined to **Jesus**, **the Anointed One**. And now **he is** our God-given wisdom, our virtue, **our holiness**, and our redemption. TPT

Ephesians 4 ³⁰ The Holy Spirit of God has sealed you in Jesus Christ until you experience your full salvation. So never grieve the Spirit of God or take for granted his holy influence in your life. TPT ³⁰ And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption. NLT

1 Thessalonians 4 ³ <u>God's will is for you to be set apart for him in holiness</u> and that you keep yourselves unpolluted from sexual defilement. TPT

Revelation 4 ⁸ Each of the four living creatures had six wings, full of eyes all around and under their wings. They worshiped without ceasing, day and night, singing, "<u>Holy</u>, <u>holy</u>, <u>holy</u>, <u>holy is the Lord God</u>, <u>the Almighty! The Was</u>, <u>the Is</u>, <u>and the Coming!</u>" ... ¹¹ "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory, honor, and power, for you created all things, and for your pleasure they were created and exist." ... ^{5:12} And as I watched, all of them were singing with thunderous voices: "Worthy is Christ the Lamb who was slaughtered to receive great power and might, wealth and wisdom, and honor, glory, and praise!" Isaiah 6 ³ They were calling out to each other, "<u>Holy</u>, <u>holy</u>, <u>holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies!</u> The whole earth is filled with his glory!" NLT

2 Corinthians 3 ⁸ Yet how much more radiant is this new and glorious ministry of the Spirit that shines from us! ⁹ For if the former ministry of condemnation was ushered in with a measure of glory, how much more does the ministry that imparts righteousness far excel in glory. ¹⁰ What once was glorious no longer holds any glory because of the increasingly greater glory that has replaced it. ... ¹⁷ Now, **the** "**Lord**" **!'m referring to is the Holy Spirit**, **and wherever he is Lord**, **there is freedom**. ¹⁸ We can all draw close to him with the veil removed from our faces. And with no veil we all become like mirrors who brightly reflect the glory of the Lord Jesus. **We are being transfigured into his very image as we move from one brighter level of glory to another**. **And this glorious transfiguration comes from the Lord**, **who is the Spirit**. TPT

1 John 4 ¹⁶ We have come into an intimate experience with God's love, and we trust in the love he has for us. God is love! Those who are living in love are living in God, and God lives through them. ¹⁷ By living in God, love has been brought to its full expression in us so that we may fearlessly face the day of judgment, **because all that Jesus now is**, **so are we in this world**. TPT

Ephesians 5 ¹⁸ And don't get drunk with wine, which is rebellion; instead **be filled continually with the Holy Spirit**. TPT

Luke 11 ¹³ If imperfect parents know how to lovingly take care of their children and give them what they need, how much more will **the perfect heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit's fullness when his children ask him**." TPT

Psalms 51 ¹ Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins. ² Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin. ³ For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night. ⁴ Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just. ⁵ For I was born a sinner—yes, from the moment my mother conceived me. ⁶ But you desire honesty from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there. ⁷ Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. ⁸ Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me—now let me rejoice. ⁹ Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt. ¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. ¹¹ Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. ¹² Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you. ¹³ Then I will teach your ways to rebels, and they will return to you. ¹⁴ Forgive me for shedding blood, O God who saves; then I will joyfully sing of your forgiveness. ¹⁵ Unseal my lips, O Lord, that my mouth may praise you. ¹⁶ You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering. ¹⁷ The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.

Psalms 100 ⁴ You can pass through his open gates with the password of praise. **Come right into his presence with thanksgiving**. Come bring your thank offering to him and affectionately bless his beautiful name! TPT
