



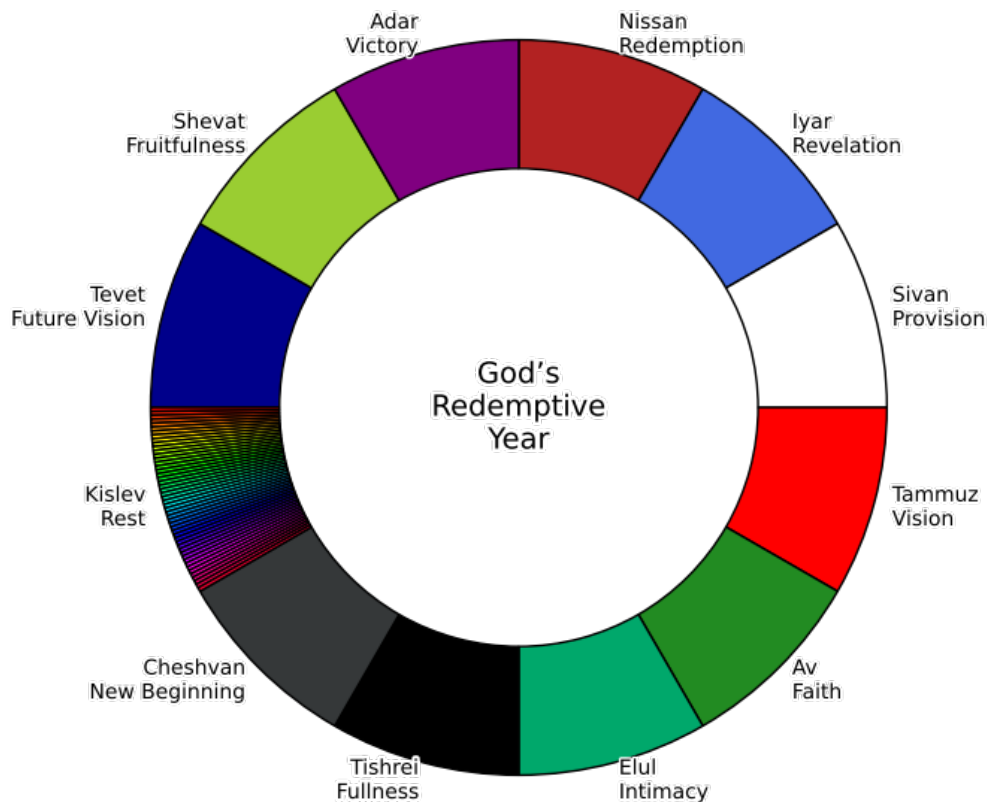
MEETING JESUS IN THE HEBREW CALENDAR: THE CYCLE THAT MAKES YOU WHOLE

Genesis 1:14 Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years.”

The word “seasons” is *mo’ed*. It means appointed times.

John 5:39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

The Hebrew Months: Nissan, Iyar, Sivan, Tammuz, Av, Elul, Tishrei, Cheshvan, Kislev, Tevet, Shevat, Adar.



Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.

THE THREAD THROUGH THE YEAR

God takes a person from: Freedom -- to transformation -- to encounter -- to maturity -- to identity

James 1:4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

The word “complete” means whole.

WHAT GOD IS ACTUALLY RESTORING

1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

God is restoring:

- Your **spirit** (your connection with Him)
- Your **soul** (your mind, will, emotions)
- Your **body** (your life, actions, and expression)

PART 1: NISSAN TO SIVAN—GOD BRINGS YOU OUT

Month 1: Nissan—Redemption

Exodus 12:2 This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you.

1 Corinthians 5:7 For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

How to encounter Jesus in Nissan: Meet Him as the Lamb of God, the Lion of Judah, and the One who gives a fresh start. Encounter Him through praise, repentance, Passover remembrance, and faith for miracles. This is the month to let Jesus lead you out, break chains, and establish a new spiritual rhythm for the year.

Month 2: Iyar—Healing and Provision

Exodus 15:26 For I am the Lord who heals you.

How to encounter Jesus in Iyar: Meet Him as Healer, Revealer, Provider, and Banner of Victory. Encounter Him by asking for wisdom, inviting healing into the wounded places, and letting Him connect what has been fragmented in spirit, soul, and mind. This is a month to seek Him for revelation and submit to His healing process.

Month 3: Sivan—Spirit Filled and Empowered

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Ephesians 5:18 Do not be drunk with wine... but be filled with the Spirit.

How to encounter Jesus in Sivan: Meet Him as Baptizer in the Holy Spirit, giver of revelation, Lord of the harvest, and the One who accelerates restoration. Encounter Him through Pentecost expectation, generous obedience, Spirit-led empowerment, and renewed surrender to His purposes.

Summary of This Season (Nissan-Sivan)

- God brings you out of bondage
- Into healing
- Into relationship

Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son.

PART 2: TAMMUZ TO ELUL — GOD TAKES YOU THROUGH

Month 4: Tammuz—The Test of Vision

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith...

How to encounter Jesus in Tammuz: Meet Him as Light, Truth, and the One who heals blind spots. Encounter Him by asking Him to search your vision, expose idols, and purify your gaze. This is the month to worship intentionally, guard your eyes, and ask Jesus to make your heart clear again.

Month 5: Av—Test of the Heart

Isaiah 53:1 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?

How to encounter Jesus in Av: Meet Him as the Lion of Judah and as the Son who reveals the Father. Encounter Him by listening for the Father's voice, rejecting unbelief, and choosing faith even when circumstances look intimidating. This is the month to believe His report and enter what He has promised.

Month 6: Elul—Intimacy Restored

James 4:8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

How to encounter Jesus in Elul: Meet Him as the near King, the Beloved, and the One who comes into your field and your boat. Encounter Him by drawing near, fixing what is broken, receiving mercy, and letting His presence reorder your life. This is a month of abiding, not striving.

Summary of This Season (Tammuz-Elul)

- God is not just delivering you.
- He is transforming you.
- He is removing idols.
- He is dealing with unbelief.
- He is drawing you close.
- God doesn't just bring you out. He brings you through.

PART 3: TISHREI — GOD BRINGS YOU INTO ENCOUNTER

Month 7: Tishrei—Awakening and Return

Malachi 3:7 "Return to Me, and I will return to you," says the Lord of hosts.

How to encounter Jesus in Tishrei: Meet Him as the One who awakens, atones, and tabernacles with His people. Encounter Him by responding to the trumpet, returning with the whole heart, letting Him cleanse bitterness, and dwelling intentionally in His presence. This is a month to let Jesus bring closure, cleansing, and fresh fruitfulness.

Summary of This Season (Tishrei)

- Wake up
- Get aligned
- Live in His presence

PART 4: CHESHVAN TO ADAR — GOD FORMS YOU INTO MATURITY

Month 8: Cheshvan—Hidden Work

Isaiah 45:15 Truly you are a God who hides Himself.

How to encounter Jesus in Cheshvan: Meet Him as Messiah in the hidden place, the One who refines after the storm, and the One who gives authority over darkness. Encounter Him by embracing quiet obedience, releasing the past, standing in His authority, and carrying His fragrance.

Month 9: Kislev—Trust

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding.

How to encounter Jesus in Kislev: Meet Him as Prince of Peace in the middle of warfare and as the One who restores the story. Encounter Him by trusting Him in conflict, resisting fear, and resting in His strength rather than your own.

Month 10: Tevet—Growth (Vision Forward)

2 Peter 3:18 Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord.

How to encounter Jesus in Tevet: Meet Him as the faithful rear guard, the source of true sight, and the One who turns suffering into witness. Encounter Him by letting Him govern your focus, mature your responses, and establish your testimony.

Month 11: Shevat—Fruitfulness

Psalm 1:3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water... yields its fruit in season.

How to encounter Jesus in Shevat: Meet Him as the Righteous One, the source of living water, and the One who causes hidden roots to grow. Encounter Him by letting Him deepen your foundation, nourish what has gone dry, and establish you in righteousness.

Month 12: Adar—Victory and Identity Established

Esther 9:1 The reverse occurred: the Jews gained mastery over those who hated them.

How to encounter Jesus in Adar: Meet Him as the One who reverses curses, exposes hidden enemies, provides from the unseen realm, and turns sorrow into joy. Encounter Him by embracing joy as a weapon, removing false identity, speaking life, trusting hidden provision, and standing in victory before Nissan begins again.

Summary of This Season (Cheshvan-Adar)

- Stability
- Growth
- Fruitfulness
- Victory
- Identity

- Your **soul** was healed, renewed, and stabilized
- Your **body** was formed, disciplined, and made fruitful
