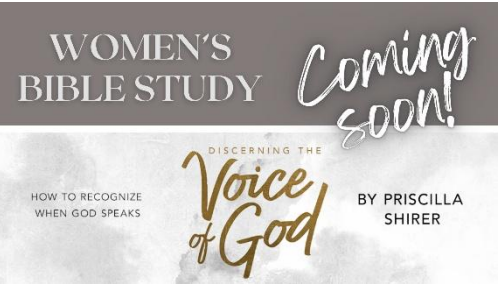
Coming Up...
