#### **WELCOME!**

Dear Parents, Grandparents, and Guardians,

Thank you so much for doing such a great thing for your young person in raising them and educating them in the Christian faith. One of the traditional "next steps" is going through the process of Confirmation.

Confirmation is not a sacrament and it is not a graduation. It is merely a time of education and an opportunity for someone to "confirm" the faith into which they were baptized. It gives people an opportunity to learn more and say that this is indeed their faith-culminating with the rite of confirmation where they make vows and promises before God, each other, and the congregation that this is their faith.

During the course of confirmation they will be educated on the Sacrament of Holy Communion. Once a student has COMPLETED this module they can be welcomed to partake in this meal of forgiveness found in our Lord's Body and Blood.

#### SERVICE HOURS

Requirements for <u>all</u> students this year:
All students will be required to complete 10 hours of service over the course of the school year.

Below is a list of opportunities but, if you have an idea about a way you would like to serve that is not listed, please talk to me and see if we can make that work!

#### Volunteer/Service hours opportunities

- Acolyting (Counts up to a max of 3 hours toward 10)
- Ushers (Counts up to a max of 3 hours toward 10)
- Day School Choir (Counts up to 5 hours out of 10 based upon attending and singing in service)
- Day School Handbells (Counts up to 5 hours out of 10 based upon attending and playing in service)
- Donut Clean up (Every 2 sundays= 1 hour)
- Slides and livestream with Parent = 1 Hour per service, no limit (Need to be trained by Robert and Allison Costa)
- Mcrest, and other church service events
- If you volunteer to serve another way or have an idea come talk to me about it and we can see if it can count toward the hours.

#### SERMON REPORTS

We will be keeping the 10 sermon report requirement as previously used.

10 Sermon Reports per school year

- If you attend Confirmation Camp at Camp Arcadia, it will count for 3 sermon reports.
- Parents MUST sign the sermon report for it to count or it will be handed back.

Please locate Sermon Report Forms to pick up and turn in at the Elder's desk in the Sanctuary.

## MODULE REQUIREMENTS - 1PS

Going forward everyone will be switching to a module system.

In order to complete a module for the process of confirmation, you will need to sign up beforehand and attend ALL of the classes for that module. (The longest module is 3 weeks in a row.)

Requirements for Public School Confirmation 1 kids:

- Service hours and Sermon reports as listed above.
- You will also be required to read through "My Journey in Faith" published by CPH with your Parent/Grandparent/Guardian/Godparent where you will go through the packet of Bible Stories and teachings outside of class time. You will be expected to go through Lessons 1-15 (over the course of the 8 months of the school year before Confirmation Sunday, which means you could do almost 2 per month.)

#### **Important:**

 By the end of Confirmation 2 next year, you should have attended all 9 modules to finish the confirmation process. You can do this at whatever pace you would like and can do them.

#### PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Parents/Guardians, we expect you to try your best to be a good example of what it means to be a follower of Jesus. That includes attending church, reading your Bible, and treating others in a Christian manner.

We are also requiring a parent/guardian to attend the following modules over the two year span:

- Bible 101 (We will also review the packet at this time.)
- Baptism Module
- Lord's Supper Module
