

The Scholars Pathway Program is a summer program designed to empower Native American, Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian College Horizons alumni in their transition from high school to college. In the SPP, the students will complete a 4-year pathway program that includes four activities: a 1-week Transition-to-College bridge program for rising first-year students, a 1-week Introduction to Indigenous Research Methodologies for rising sophomores, a 3-day Pre-Graduate & Research Institute for rising juniors, and a 3day Graduate Horizons for rising seniors. Throughout the year, students will receive academic coaching and opportunities to engage through a more robust and contiguous Scholars Pathway Program to better meet

their mentoring, academic, socio-emotional, pre-graduate advising, and research needs.
