Less than 1% of NOC's total population is currently affected with .09% in quarantine due to close contact exposure and .04% with positive cases in isolation.

0 individuals from Enid residence halls and 0 individuals from Tonkawa residence halls are isolating in a college-sponsored quarantine location.

There are currently 10 recovered cases.

As of this advisory, NOC is aware of 16 individuals institution-wide who have tested positive for COVID-19 since the start of the pandemic, and who were on campus during the time when they may have been infected.

Since June 1, 2020, there has been a total of 22 positive cases reported involving NOC employees and students.
