Minimum Grade Requirements

- 1. Average in all college course work and course work at UCO......2.75
- 3. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in each course in the major to count toward meeting degree requirements.

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
- 60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions

A good general guideline would be a limit of 64 total hours from a community college.
