The following is an example 8-semester plan. This is used to illustrate the course sequencing and the expectations for course loading. Students may use this as a guide as they plan their undergraduate education, but should adjust it to fit their personal goals. Students are responsible for completing requirements in the official degree sheet for each major. It is mandatory for a student to meet with an academic advisor prior to course enrollment each semester.

This curriculum identifies courses to be taken at NOC, that are equivalent to or will substitute for required courses counting toward the major in Physical Education, option in Teacher Education (2017-2018 OSU EHA/PHED degree sheet only).

### Oklahoma State University Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- 40 hours must be upper-division
- A 2.50 Major GPA is required for graduation.
- A 2.50 Professional Core GPA is required for graduation.
- A 2.50 College/Departmental GPA is required for graduation.
- A 2.50 minimum overall GPA is required for graduation.
- At least: 60 hours at a four-year institution; 30 hours completed at OSU; 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours.



- Meet with Academic Advisor at OSU


#### Senior Year at OSU


