Award type:

Each year, at least one study abroad scholarship will be awarded depending on resources available. The target award amount for 2023-24 is between \$500-750; this depends on the annual amount contributed from the previous year and the number and quality of applicants. This scholarship will be awarded to a current or former NOC student and based on merit. Financial need will also be considered. An applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and be a full-time higher education student at the time of application for the scholarship award and time of travel. Preference will be given to candidates who are full-time NOC students demonstrating leadership potential, scholastic aptitude, and financial need. The study abroad program may be from any accredited higher education institution. However, a high priority will be given to students who are participating in NOC- sponsored programs. One NOC/OSU Gateway recipient will receive the Quirey Family Study Abroad Scholarship in recognition of Mrs. Debbie Quirey, a retired NOC-Stillwater Vice President, and her family, and their appreciation of and support for student travel and study abroad. The remaining scholarships will be awarded as the NOC Study Abroad Scholarship(s). For 2023-24 up to three \$2000 study abroad scholarships may be awarded to assist students looking to add an international experience to their academic résumé.
