Gas and Water Committee Report: Committee Chair, Trustee Whitlow

- Trustee Whitlow advised that last month 46 red letters were sent out with 1 shut off.
- Trustee Whitlow advised they have a couple projects they are working on. The hydrants were removed on Grooms Street leaving that area lacking in fire protection. He has a materials estimate of \$11,059.15. One of the hydrants they removed was from 1970. The other they have been using for parts. The hydrants will go back at 1 2th and Carroll St. and 11th and Grooms St;. Motion made by Trustee Whitlow to approve an amount not to exceed \$12,000 for purchase of replacement parts and hydrants.

Trustee Whitlow advised they need to replace the gas main down Lincoln Street between 8th and 10th Streets and around Henkle Drive. They have estimated 1000ft of gas main at a material cost of approximately \$18,000 plus \$4,000 to have it bored.

Consensus was to ask him to move it and advised him it is not legal as the tags are expired. Trustee Murphy suggested if he doesn't move it, to ask her where she would like a handicapped parking spot and label it that way as opposed to a no parking sign. Consensus was to proceed with the handicapped parking spot. Chief Harris will ask him to move the vehicle and we will revisit this at the next meeting.
- Treasurer Brent Wise advised he received a call from a resident on the 500 block of Washington. There are several kids in the area and they would like a "Slow Children at Play" sign. Consensus was to obtain and install the sign.
