

Pawnee Prairie Days Angel Tree Program

Dear Parents,

The Pawnee Prairie Days Assoc is co-ordinating the Pawnee Angel Tree this year. Prairie Days wants to serve families in need by giving Christmas presents to children where there might not be any otherwise. This is for worthy families with children still living at home that are unable to buy Christmas presents for their own children because of financial hardship. This is not a program to supplement someones own Christmas shopping.

To be eligible the family must live in Pawnee School District and have a need for assistance. Angel Tree Forms will be sent home from the school explaining the program. Forms are also available at the Pawnee Village Office, Pawnee Public Library and Snelling Chevalier Real Estate.

The Angel Tree form must be completed and return by Thursday, November 13th, 2025. Place signed form in a sealed envelope with "ANGEL TREE" written on the outside and return it to the following drop box locations: Village Utility Office (west side of Square) or Pawnee Public Library (north side of Square). Forms can also be mailed to: Pawnee Prairie Days, PO Box 346, Pawnee, IL 62558

Filling out this form does not guarantee presents and all forms with false information will not be honored. The pick up date for the presents will be Saturday, December 20th from 9:00am to 11:00am at the Pawnee Public Library in the Bowsher Building next to the Library. The parents that sign the form are the only ones allowed to pick up presents – ID required on pick up day - no exceptions. If you are unable to make this pick-up, call/text (217)414-5605 or (217)691-4512 prior to pick up date to make alternative arrangements. Presents not picked up by 11:00am on Dec 20th will be given to the proper charitable organizations for distribution.
